Summary: Snowboard Yukon is seeking a lead coach to draft and implement lessons and a seasonal plan, organize assistant coaches and facilitate the E-Team program, and communicate with parents. This program is for our Territorial stream of athletes who are developing their snowboarding skills and the focus is 'Learning to Train', Stage 4, of the LTAD model. Most coaching is on snow; however participation in the dryland programs is strongly encouraged. On snow training occurs primarily at Mt. Sima.

Qualifications: Minimum NCCP A and Canada Snowboard Competition Introduction Course Trained (with a commitment to get NCCP B and certified CSCP this season); Current CSCP Coaching license including criminal record check. CASI Level 2 may apply; proven athletic and/or coaching experience at a competitive level; reasonable proficiency with standard computer systems; current basic first aid certification; demonstrated knowledge of the LTAD program. Valid Class 5 drivers licence.

Desired Knowledge Skills and Suitability: Experience in a competition environment, experience coaching or being coached, experience working in a cross-sport environment. Ability to work in a team environment. Ability to work with youth. Must have access to a computer, internet/telephone.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities: Coach and support athletes at practice and in competition. Prepare yearly training plan including daily lessons for the E-Team team. Work with the team coach and provide input to the overall season plan. Coach weekends and on competition days with at least a minimum level of 80% of on snow participation. Evaluate and monitor athlete performance attributes (technical, physical, mental preparedness). Organize and ensure sufficient numbers of coaches present for training and competition days. Communicate with parents regarding athletes, schedule, competitions and program etc. Be knowledgeable in emergency procedures at training and completion venues. Monitor and report on program budget. Provide a written report to the board of directors at the conclusion of the on-snow season.

Specific Accountabilities: Set goals with athletes within the LTAD framework for the season. Prepare year-long training plan and lesson plans for team as per goals of program and athlete. Coach and develop athletes. Monitor athlete and coach attendance. Work with other staff and individual athletes as required addressing specific issues or concerns. Develop and maintain a positive, constructive, and inclusive relationship with athletes, other staff and coaches, Mt. Sima staff, or any other key partners or stakeholders involved with Snowboard Yukon. Other related duties as the need arises.

Working Environment: Various outdoor & weather conditions (10°C to -30°C). Be prepared for any outdoor situation.
